Criteria for Submission of Posters:

1. Personal/Professional Details.

- Full name
- Place of work and/or study
- Professional status/job title
- Postal address
- Telephone/fax number (including international dialling codes)
- E-mail address

2. Title of Poster

3. A summary and key words

- Not more than 50 words
- Indicate how the content relates to the conference theme/strands

4. The Main Abstract

- Not more than 200 words
- Objectives of the poster
- If previously presented, a summary of where and when

General Guidelines

Submissions must be made in **electronic format** on or before **Friday 6th April 2018**. If the abstract is accepted you will be notified on or before Friday 20th April 2018. (Submitters who require earlier notice of acceptance will be accommodated upon request.)

Poster display panels measure approximately 1m x 1m and will fit an A0 size poster in portrait format. If your poster will not fit within these measurements, you must notify us at the time of submission, giving the measurements of your poster.

Posters are mounted onto display boards using Velcro fasteners, which the conference organisers provide.
